

SNOHOMISH SCHOOL DISTRICT ATHLETICS

Dear Parent(s) & Student:

Welcome to Snohomish School District Athletics! The required forms for athletic participation include the attached four pages: 1) the ATHLETIC EMERGENCY AND CLEARANCE FORM, 2) the ATHLETIC ELIGIBILITY FORM, 3) the ATHLETIC/ACTIVITY CODE 4) the yellow PHYSICAL EXAMINATION form, and 5) the CONCUSSION INFORMATION SHEET. The PHYSICAL EXAMINATION form is valid for twenty-four (24) months from the physician's signed date of the exam. However, an exam must be valid for the duration of the entire sport season in order to tryout/begin a sport. All forms need to be filled out, signed, and turned in to your school prior to tryouts/first practice for each sport.

VISION STATEMENT

The staff at Valley View Middle School is committed to providing co-curricular and extra-curricular programs that will help all students achieve their potential.

MISSION STATEMENT

All students are encouraged to participate in the co-curricular and extra-curricular programs at the middle school level. It is the responsibility of all students to make learning a top priority and to be accountable for their work and personal conduct at all times. To remain eligible to participate, all students will demonstrate, through their work and attitude that they are working to their fullest potential. Students will exemplify good character in the classroom and in co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

ATHLETIC ACADEMIC STANDARDS

Students are expected to maintain satisfactory academic performance in all school courses. Although an athlete can continue to practice with the team, they cannot compete unless they are continually enrolled in and passing a minimum of five classes. A student athlete must maintain a "C" grade in each class.

ATHLETIC HEALTH STANDARDS

Possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages or use of tobacco products in any form will not be tolerated. Possession, use of, or trafficking in drugs of any kind or substances purported to be drugs, not prescribed by a physician, will not be tolerated.

First Offense: Permanent removal from team unless athlete agrees to one of the WIAA sanctioned options. (See Athletic/Activity Code for details.)

Second Offense: Permanent removal from team for remainder of season.

Third Offense: Removal from athletic program for full calendar year.

Disciplinary actions regarding athletic code violations shall be progressive and cumulative over the four-year career of the athlete. Please refer to the Athletic/Activity Code for full detail of rules.

ASB CARD/PARTICIPATION FEE

Athletes must purchase an ASB Card. Additionally, due to the rising costs associated with the Snohomish School District's Athletics Program; the District approved a participation fee of \$50 per sport with a maximum of \$100 per year. This fee can be waived for students who have a current Free and Reduced Lunch Approval on file with the District (*If your child is eligible please provide a copy of the letter you received from special programs in the payment envelope to our bookkeeper, Mrs. Dalrymple*). The athletic participation fee is due prior to the first contest and shall be paid (*or letter submitted*) by using the Athletic Fee envelope provided by the coach. Refunds will not be provided after the first contest.
